### STAY ON THE TRAIL

Please remain on the trail to avoid damaging fragile flora and alpine tundra, which could take years to recover.



### KNOW WHEN TO YIELD

Uphill hikers have the right-of-way. Bikers should yield the trail to hikers, and both bikers and hikers need to yield to equestrians.



### PASS ON THE LEFT

Please stay on the right side of trails, allowing others to pass on the left. Large groups should hike single file to avoid taking up the entire path.

### FOLLOW DOG LAWS

Some areas allow dogs to be off leash, but most have a leash law. Please leash your dog on the trail and remember to pick up after your pet.



### TRASH THE TRASH

Please pack out all trash, including dog waste and summit signs. Don't remove or vandalize any part of the outdoor environment.
